Salary Survey sites that provide multiple coded salary survey sources are often using private copyrighted information without permission. Most other online survey sites have large sampling error rates due to limited participation.

Almost all other Online Salary Survey Sites use data supplied directly by users/employees. Such unprofessional salary survey practices normally yield very large errors and generally invalidates all survey offerings from that site. CompGeo Online strictly prohibits any use of user/employee direct supplied data in order to protect the integrity and reliability of the CompGeo Salary and Compensation Database.

Most other Online Salary Survey Sites estimate a significant portion of salary information based partially or entirely on cost-of-living ratios or general salary survey differentials related to broad non occupation specific salary levels. All such practices are strictly prohibited in the CompGeo Online Salary Survey Research system insuring clients that all survey information is based on actual salary survey data specific to each Benchmark and geographic salary survey area.

The CompGeo Database has been updated yearly since 1991 using hundreds of carefully screened government conducted private and public sector salary surveys which have the lowest sampling error rates available.
